

# Possible trips outside Prague

## Karlštejn Castle

Founded in 1348 by Charles IV, Karlštejn Castle used to safeguard royal treasures. Explore its rich history, Gothic, Renaissance, and purist styles, and iconic Great Tower.



## Kutná Hora

Kutná Hora, a historic town famous for silver mining since the 13th century. UNESCO-listed for its architectural treasures such as St. Barbara's Cathedral and the Bone Church.



## Nelahozeves

Nelahozeves, the birthplace of the famous composer Antonín Dvořák, has a beautiful chateau in its centre. A rich palette of history and culture is waiting to be discovered.



## Litomyšl

Litomyšl, a historic city with a Renaissance chateau, listed by UNESCO. Birthplace of the Czech composer Bedřich Smetana, famous for its annual music festival.
